

Road Safety Week schedule (14th – 18th of November)

- Lessons and activities can be done anytime during the week – this is just a suggested schedule
- Competition to run throughout week
- **'Be seen, Be bright' day on Friday**

Monday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • P6/5 will be running a survey to gather data and pupils' opinions about their journey to school. A group of pupils from P6/5 will visit your class at some point throughout the day. • Introduction to safe roads for all - First level: Lesson plan 1 • Introduce banner competition
Tuesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Early/first level – Beep Beep day resources. • Lesson plan (learning about young people who have campaigned for change)
Wednesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walk around Stockbridge (Early level – how to walk safely, looking at zebra crossings, speed signs, traffic lights, pavements) (First/second level – what problems do we see? How could we change this?) • Campaigning for Safe roads for all (Second/first level: persuasive writing to MP/council about a road safety issue within the Stockbridge community)
Thursday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • P6/5 reading with Nursery at 10am. • Design a new, safer street/town which is created for the needs of the people not traffic (could use Stockbridge as a local example) See lesson plan 3 for details.
Friday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Be Seen, Be Bright' day. Encourage pupils to come to school dressed in bright clothing to remind drivers to look out for people who walk and ride (teachers too).
