The children loved hearing why Emily had chosen a rabbit to be the central character in her Ralfy books.





Emily was so supportive and encouraging, patiently guiding the children through the drawing and reminding them not to worry about getting it wrong.



"I liked drawing the head the best, and the ears with the bit inside."
